definition of

PER CAPITA

2026

Per Capita is the designated dollar amount that is asked of each member of the Presbytery Church (USA) as a yearly voluntary contribution. Per Capita is collected by the Presbytery.

It is based on the church's membership on your annual statistical report from two years prior (2024).

Each church is encouraged to give its full requested share of per capita, regardless of how it collects the funds.

WHAT IS THE COST FOR 2026 PER MEMBER?



Per Capita is “the tie that binds” – providing the means to strengthen the connections of our work and build lasting relationships to help all Presbyterians share God’s love through mission and ministry.

Per Capita for 2026

General Assembly	\$ 11.08
Synod of Lincoln Trails	\$ 3.81
Blackhawk Presbytery	<u>\$ 30.11</u>
Total Cost per Member	\$45.00

This amount is paid by the Presbytery to the Synod of Lincoln Trails and General Assembly regardless of what is actually collected.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY PER CAPITA..

Per Capita for the General Assembly covers the biannual meeting, moderator expenses, committee and commission expenses, membership and participation in national and international ecumenical groups, administrative and personnel expenses and building operations.

SYNOD OF LINCOLN TRAILS

Per Capita supports the Office of the Synod Executive/Stated Clerk, Administrative staff, the annual Synod Assembly, Ecclesiastical committees and Synod Council.

BLACKHAWK PRESBYTERY

Presbytery’s per capita pays for:

- Council and Committees
- Committee on Preparation for Ministry
- Committee on Ministry
- Presbytery resources and training
- Presbytery meetings and operations
- Personnel expenses
